MUST READ! Important Information and Criteria of Kyorugi Individual Classification

Kyorugi are using new rules update (01 January, 2026 by World Taekwondo Rules)

- Rookie – Class D: Not allowed head kicks and techniques of spinning kicks: Only White & Yellow Belt can be registered (The group will be divided into 2-3 people/group maximum matches will be 2 matches fight. All kids will get medals.
-
- Beginners – Class C: Not allowed head kicks and techniques of spinning kicks: Only White & Yellow & Green Belt can be registered (The group will be divided into 2-3 people/group maximum matches will be 2 matches' fight. All kids will get medals.
- Intermediate – Class B: Allowed head kicks and techniques of spinning kicks except spinning head kicks are not allowed (6 points Techniques): Only color belts not allow Poom or Black Belt (The group of athletes will be divided into 3 to 4 people/ group maximum matches will be maximum 2 rounds fight. All kids will get medals.
- Advance – Class A (Open): Allowed head kicks and all technique kicks: All belt colors are allowed (Color – Poom / Dan Belt): **Please note!** The group of each weight category will not be divided. Athletes must win their match to receive the medals. (The player who lost before Semi – Final, will receive medal with certificate of participation)

Athletes or coaches may request a face shield for their athletes in any class rank accept Class A, also class C, D can request sport glasses for athletes. However, for group above the cadet level only Class B division participants are eligible to make this request. **Additionally, each player is allowed to participate in only one weight division.**

Kyorugi Competition Rules

- Single-elimination system for each weight category (Men's/Women's).
- WT Competition Rules (01 January 2026, Kyorugi) apply.

Equipment & Safety

- WT-approved gear or local brands following WT standards.
- Required gear: Groin guard, forearm guard, sensing socks, gloves, mouthpiece, etc.
- WT-recognized uniform (white) must be worn, with all protective gear properly placed.

Weigh-In

- Held one day before competition.
- Clothing: Male – underpants; Female – underpants & sports bra. Nude weigh-in allowed for 18+ (except juniors, will get a 100g allowance).
- One attempt allowed; a second chance is given within 60 minutes if needed.
- Required documents: ID card & Passport (or National ID with competition accreditation).
- Changes may occur at the Head of Team Meeting.

Participant Regulations

1. One weight category per age group; athletes may allow to compete in higher age categories.
2. Incomplete applications may be rejected.
3. All athletes must comply with competition rules.
4. Required: Personal Passport & Taekwondo Promotion Certification.
5. Religious items must be worn under the uniform and should not cause harm or obstruction.
6. Each athlete is allowed only one coach during their match.
7. If an athlete is competing in multiple events (Kyorugi & Poomsae) and faces a schedule conflict, they must inform the court staff or referee to avoid disqualified for a no-show.
8. If a team does not have enough coaches, senior athletes or assistants may act as coaches. However, they must be registered as a coach in advance to gain entry into the competition area.

Match Format & Regulations

- Two 3rd place winners are allowed (“1, 2, 3, 3”).
- Match duration: 1-2 minutes per round, 2 – 3 rounds, with 20-second to 1-minute breaks (adjustable), Time schedule can be adjusted according to organizer committee.
- Report: Athletes must arrive at least 30 minutes before their match.
- No-shows will be called three times within three minutes before disqualification.

Poomsae Elimination Competition:

- Judging System:
 - Three referees will evaluate the performance.
 - A randomly selected Poomsae will be displayed on the screen.
 - The elimination system will be used for all rounds in both colors belt and the Poom – Dan Rank Belt category.
- Score Distribution: Total Score: 10.0
 - Accuracy: 4.0 points
 - 0.1-point deduction for minor mistakes in individual movements.
 - 0.3-point deduction for significant mistakes in individual movements.
 - Presentation: 6.0 points
 - Speed & Power: 2.0 points
 - Rhythm & Tempo: 2.0 points
 - Expression of Energy: 2.0 points
- Contest Duration: 1 minute 30 seconds – 1 minute 40 seconds
- Awards & Qualification:
 - Competitors who advance to the Semifinals and Finals will receive medals.
 - Participants eliminated in earlier rounds will still receive medals and a certificate of participation.

Poomsae Freestyle Competition

The winner will be determined based on the ranking score. The athlete with the highest score will be declared the winner, followed by the next highest scores in ranking order.

Note: Scoring follows the official World Taekwondo rules. (September 30, 2024)

Taekwondo Dance

1. Team Format

- Each team must consist of 7–9 members, gender is not restricted.
- There are two age divisions:
 - Under 15 years old
 - 15 years old and above

2. Competition Format

- Teams will be ranked based on total average score.
- The team with the highest score will be awarded the Best Performance Trophy.

3. Judging Criteria

- The performance will be evaluated by a panel of 5 judges using the following criteria:
 1. Synchronization of taekwondo skills, dance movements, and musical rhythm
 2. Completeness and clarity of techniques and gestures
 3. Entertainment value and overall presentation
 4. Team coordination and synchronization
 5. Formation and aesthetic arrangement on stage

4. Performance Duration

- The maximum performance time is 5 minutes.

5. Costumes

- Costumes should be creative, beautiful, and appropriate.
- Safety must be prioritized in the costume design.

6. Music Submission

- Coaches or instructors must submit the music to the sound technician team prior to the competition.
- Music can be provided via USB drive or direct device connection.
- A pre-test of the music file is required before the actual performance.

SPEED KICK CATEGORY**Speed Kick Competition Rules**

1. Individual Contest Duration: Each athlete has 30 seconds to kick within the designated target area. The winner is determined by the highest number of successful kicks with the correct power and accuracy.
2. Team Format (3 Athletes):
 - The first athlete kicks for 30 seconds, followed by the second athlete for another 30 seconds, and finally, the third athlete kicks for 30 seconds.
 - The total score from all three athletes is combined.
 - The team with the highest total score wins.

WT Recognized Brands

- Participating contestants are **not required** to wear WT-recognized uniforms or protective equipment brands, also allowed to wear the local brands following WT standards.

Dress Code

- Coaches must wear a neat tracksuit, shirt with long pants, or a sports team jacket. Proper attire is required.
- More details about the dress code will be provided during the Head of Team Meeting.
- Athletes must wear the correct uniform as shown in the official guidelines.
 - Failure to comply may result in a deduction (-0.8) or disqualification.

Indemnities

- All participants must ensure they complete and agree to the required declarations during registration.
- By registering, participants indemnify the organizers, officials, and fellow competitors against claims related to injuries, losses, fatalities, or other incidents occurring during the championship.

Weigh-In

- Weigh-in will take place before the start of the respective weight category.
- Each athlete has one (1) attempt to pass the weigh-in.
- If the athlete fails, one (1) extra attempt is allowed within the official weigh-in schedule.

Head of Team Meeting & Drawing of Lots

- The Head of Team Meeting will be conducted by the Heroes Taekwondo Committee.
- The exact location and time will be communicated in advance.
- The drawing of lots will be available on the official website www.gmacscore.com/match/455
- The Head of Team Meeting is scheduled on 30 July 2026, from 14:00 – 16:00, at Eastern National Sports Training Center, Pattaya city Chonburi
- **Any changes will be communicated as soon as possible.**

Visa Requirements

- A visa may be required to enter Thailand.
- The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry but can provide assistance.
- It is the responsibility of each athlete and team to apply for and secure the correct entry visa.

Accommodation

- Recommended hotel options will be provided in the official package documents.

Referees

- **Referees must submit the relevant application form** to the Heroes Taekwondo Committee at cassandra.chz@gmail.com by 10 May 2026 for approval.

Entry Fees & Deadlines

- Entry fees must be paid before the registration deadline via:
 - Cash on Arrival: Team **must first pay a 30% deposit** of the entry fee to secure their registration. **The remaining balance can be paid upon arrival.**
 - Bank Transfer
 - Western Union
 - Wise Transfer
 - PayPal (+5% Additional added)
- Athletes will not be allowed to compete without verified payment to the Organizing Committee.

Additional Information

- Multi-Event Registration:
 - Contestants can register for more than one competition event, including:
 - Kyorugi
 - Poomsae
 - Freestyle Poomsae
 - Taekwondo Dance
 - Speed Kick, Speed Punch
 - Each club/team can enter multiple athletes in the same category.

- Protest & Appeals:
 - Only the Team Manager / Head Coach has the right to file a protest.
 - The protest must be submitted within 15 minutes after the match.
 - A USD 500 protest fee is required.
 - If the protest is upheld, the fee will be refunded.
 - The referee's decision is final. Any team or athlete who disputes the decision may face disqualification and be reported to World Taekwondo.
- Video Evidence:
 - The Organizing Committee does not provide video recording equipment for scoring disputes.
 - Teams may bring their own video recording devices for evidence.
- Food Policy:
 - Food and food preparation are strictly prohibited in the competition area.
 - Please use the designated dining area.
- Access Restrictions:
 - Non-contestants are not allowed inside the competition court.
 - Spectators must remain in their designated team seating area.

Weigh-In Guidelines

- Each athlete is allowed two (2) weigh-in attempts.
 - If the athlete fails to meet the required weight after the second attempt, they will be disqualified.
- All athletes must bring their Passport and present it to the committee during weigh-in.
- Class B & C participants **must also bring their Belt Test Certificate** along with their Passport.

Important Notice

- Changes to weight or weight category upon arrival (after registration closes) will incur a **\$40 USD processing fee**.
- Failure to meet weight requirements will result in disqualification and NO – SHOW, the athlete **will not receive any medals or certificates**.
- Late Registration: After the official registration deadline, late registration will be available for a **\$120 USD** fee.

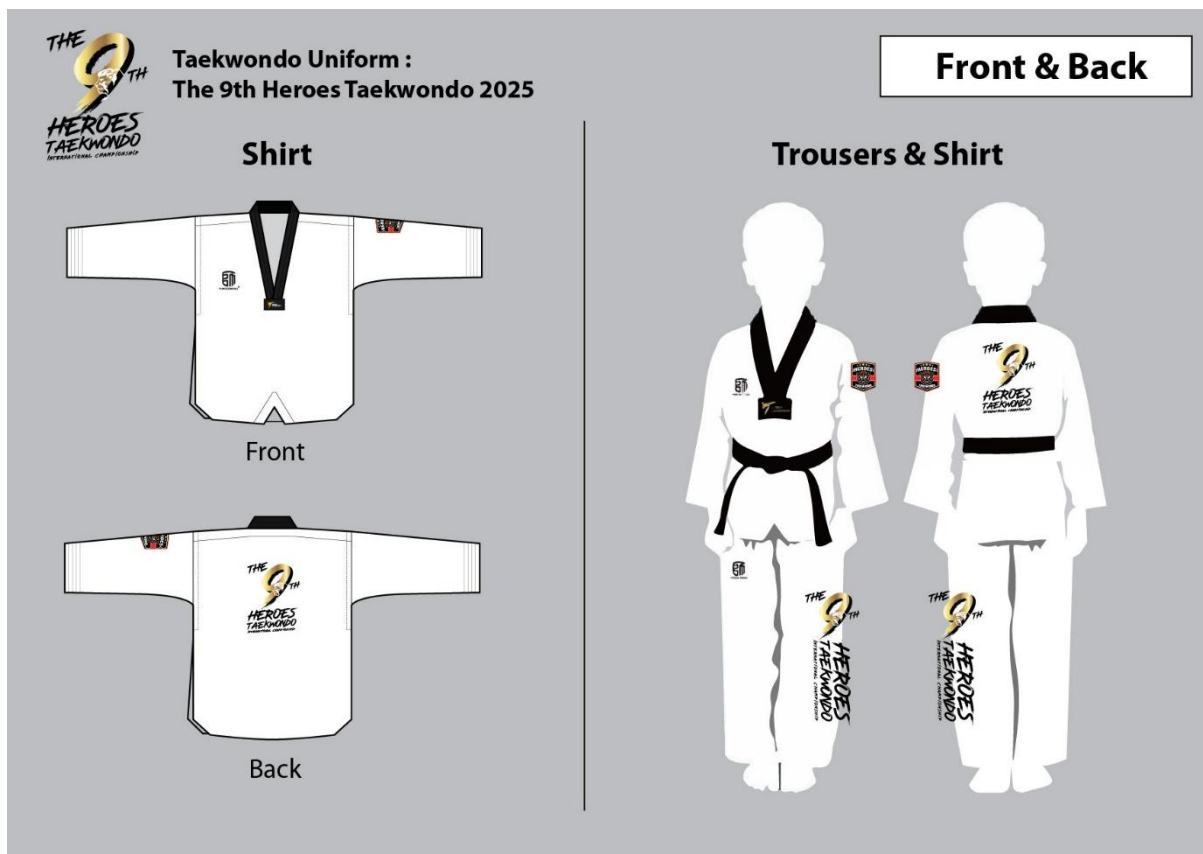

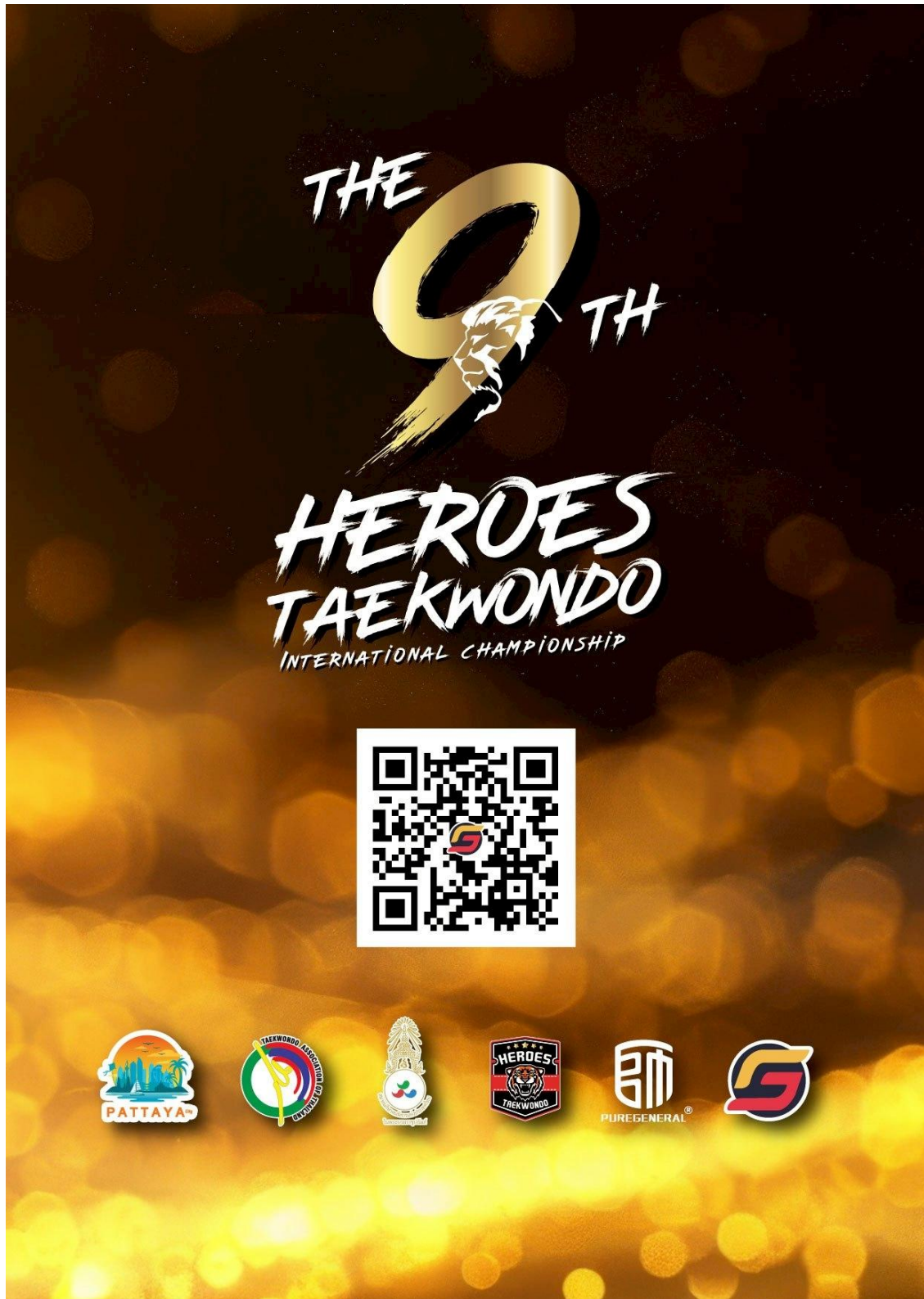
